

# monkeying AROUND

## Game Rules

### Object of the game:

Carefully hang the monkeys on the palm tree. The more monkeys that hang, the more of a chance that the palm tree will fall and the monkeys will scatter. The first player who can hang all of his or her monkeys on the tree successfully, wins the game!

### Before you begin:

Insert the palm tree trunk into the game base and attach the leaves.

Place the game in the middle of the table where all players can reach it easily.

Each player claims one set of 8 colored monkeys & 1 large monkey that matches.

### Playing the game:

The youngest player starts the game. On your turn, spin the spinner dial at the base of the palm tree to see how many monkeys you must hang on the tree. You can place the monkeys anywhere on the tree, directly from the branches or from any other monkey already hanging in the tree.

If you spin the dial and it lands on the picture of the large monkey, you must hang your large monkey in the tree. (If you have already placed your large monkey in the tree, then your turn is over)

It is the next player's turn.

### Winning the game:

Whoever is first to hang all of his or her monkeys on the palm tree wins the game.

If, before any player can do this, the palm tree topples, then the player with the least monkeys left wins.

### Variation of play:

This game follows the rules above except you must hang your monkeys from another monkey of the same color. If there is no monkey of that color already on the tree, you can place the monkey anywhere.

### One player game:

Try to put all the monkeys onto the palm tree without it collapsing!
