

Game Rules for Trivia Challenge

2+ players

Before you begin:

Shuffle the cards well and place them facedown on the table where all players can reach them.

Playing the game:

The shuffler begins the game by drawing the top card and reading it aloud. Whoever thinks they know the answer shouts it out. The shuffler checks the answer at the bottom of the card. The first player to correctly shout out the answer wins the card.

The player to the left of the shuffler now draws a card and reads it aloud. The game continues with players taking turns reading cards. When it is your turn to read, you cannot guess the answer.

When all players have read 5 questions each, the game is over.

Winning the game:

The player who has won the most cards after 5 rounds of play wins the game.

Note: You can play more rounds for a longer game. As long as each player reads an equal amount of questions, you can continue to play until you have finished the deck.

Game Rules for Head-to-Head Trivia

2 players

Before you begin:

Shuffle the cards and deal out the complete deck so that each player has 45 cards. Players keep their decks facedown in front of them (draw pile)

Playing the game:

The dealer (player A) starts the game by turning over the top card in his/her draw pile and reading the question to his/her opponent (player B). If player B answers correctly, he/she gets to keep the card. The card is placed face-up in a separate pile in front of player B. If the question is answered incorrectly, the card is set aside, in a discard pile. It is now player B's turn to turn over his/her top card and read it to player A. Again, if player A answers correctly, he/she gets to keep the card and places it in a separate face-up pile in front of him/her. An incorrect response means the card is placed in the discard pile.

The game continues until both players have read all 45 cards in their draw piles.

Winning the game:

The player who answered the most questions correctly wins the game.

Game Rules for Team Trivia

For 2 teams

Before you begin:

Divide players into 2 teams. Shuffle the cards and place them in a pile, facedown on the table. You will need a timer or a watch, paper, and a pencil.

Playing the game:

Decide which team goes first. Set the timer or have a player from the opposing team keep track of time. Pick who is going to read for round one. One, two, three, go. The reader takes the top card from the pile and reads the trivia question. The rest of the team hurries to try to answer.

·If they answer correctly the card is placed face-up and the reader picks up another card and reads another question.

·If the team doesn't know the answer, they quickly say "pass". The card is placed facedown on the table. When one minute is up, the reader stops.

·The team gets 1 point for every face-up card, but must subtract 1 point for every facedown card. It is the next team's turn.

Winning the game:

After you have played 3 rounds (each team has had 3 turns), the team with the most points wins.

Game Rules for Elimination Trivia

3+ players

Before you begin:

Shuffle and deal out 1 card to each player, facedown.

Playing the game:

The player to the left of the dealer (player A) starts the game by reading the question on his/her card to the player on his/her left (player B). If player B answers the question correctly he/she gets to keep the card, face-up in front of him/her. Player B now reads his/her facedown card to the player on his/her left (player C), and so on, with the dealer reading last.

At the end of a round, any player who does NOT have a face-up card in front of him/her is eliminated.

Player A now deals out cards to the remaining players, placed facedown in front of them (if player A has been eliminated then player B deals, etc) and the game continues.

Winning the game:

When there is only one player left who has answered all questions correctly, the game is over. This player is the champion!
